The Virtual Advice Clinic is a partnership between the Legal Aid Society of Cleveland, Cleveland Bar Association's Women in Law and Women's Business Center to provide **free specialized support for driven, low-income entrepreneurs who operate in economically disadvantaged areas or who have limited financial resources.**

Volunteer attorneys can help business owners with any non-criminal business-related matters such as:

- Reviewing legal documents
- Answering questions about starting a business
- Taxation
- Real estate leases
- Employment law
- Legal issues common to small business owners

Who is eligible?

- ECDI clients and WBC members
- Entrepreneurs who own and operate a business that are female, a minority and/or socially or economically disadvantaged

How do I apply?

What happens after I'm referred?

Once the WBC submits the referral, a Legal Aid intake specialist will contact you to determine if you are income eligible for the clinic and complete the intake process.
